Paper size: A4 (210x297 mm). Margins: top, bottom, left – 25 mm, right – 20 mm. To prepare your paper please use the text editor *Microsoft Word*, format: *.doc* or *.docx*.

Paper format:

The paper format template is in the attached file, as well as on the conference website.

Guidelines to prepare your paper are as follows:

- UDC. Font: size 13 pt; type *Times New Roman*, alignment left, writing capital letters. Empty line.
- Paper title. Font: size 13 pt; type *Times New Roman*, alignment centered, writing capital letters, style bold. No more than three lines.

Photographs of the authors sized 40x37 mm.

A caption under each photo: last name and first name initials of the author. Font: size – 12 pt, type – *Times New Roman*, style – bold, italic, alignment – centered.

Photos, last name and first name initials of the author(s) should be placed in table cells with transparent borders (one author – one cell).

Under last name and first name initials of the author indicate place of work and designation (full title), email for correspondence. Font: size – 11 pt; type – *Times New Roman*, style – italics, alignment – centered.

Empty line.

Brief biographies of the authors.

- First name initials, last name of the author. Font: size 10 pt; type *Times New Roman*, style italic, bold, alignment left, no indentation.
- Biographical information about the authors. Font: size 10 pt; type *Times New Roman*, style italics, alignment left, paragraph indent 10 mm.
 Empty line.
- Abstract (brief description of the paper purpose and main results) in the amount of 50-100 words (5-10 lines). Font: size 10 pt; type *Times New Roman*, paragraph indent 10 mm.
- Key words (5-10 words). Font: size 10 pt; type Times New Roman, paragraph indent 10 mm.

Empty line.

Paper structure:

-introduction;

- main text;
- -conclusion.

Font: size – 12 pt; type – *Times New Roman*, paragraph indent – 10 mm, alignment – width. Line spacing and spacing between paragraphs – single. Pages are not numbered.

Drawings should be made with dimensions of at least 60x60 mm and no more than 110x170 mm only in *.jpg* or *.bmp* format. The requirement of "one caption per picture" should be adhered to. Drawings consisting of elements marked with the letters "a)", "b)", etc. should be inserted as a single *.jpg* or *.bmp* image. It is not allowed to use pictures created using *Microsoft Word* tools.

The titles and numbers of figures are indicated below the figures, the titles and numbers of tables are indicated above the tables.

Tables, diagrams, figures, formulas, graphs should not go beyond the specified fields (font size in tables and pictures is at least 11 pt).

Formulas, tables, and figures are placed in the center of the page.

Footnotes to the reference literature are indicated in square brackets. The reference list is required.

Reference literature – font: size – 10 pt; type – *Times New Roman*, paragraph indent – 10 mm, alignment – width.
